

# VANDALISM

It is our unfortunate duty to report to you that an unusually large number of acts of vandalism have recently afflicted our community.

1. The Old Farm Lake entry sign at the confluence of Old Farm Road and Rambling Brook Road was nearly destroyed.
2. The men's and women's rooms in our clubhouse were trashed.
3. The main salon in our clubhouse has experienced cigarette butts ground into the flooring, empty snack bags strewn across the floors, beer bottles left everywhere, beer emptied on tables, and a general disregard for our clubhouse property.
4. The lamp post in front of unit #5 at Deer Run was split in half and the night light destroyed.
5. The 12-unit mailbox stands in front of Deer Run unit #5 and #140 were torn from their foundations and thrown to the ground strewing important resident mail to the winds.
6. Numerous unchaperoned teenagers, boys and girls, have been seen in the clubhouse on weekends at midnight. Most of the intruders are not from Old Farm Lake but some of them are. It appears that a young Old Farm Lake person who has an entry key to our clubhouse opens the front door. Do you have a teenager who has an entry key?
7. People should remember that young men and women are not allowed in the clubhouse unless supervised and accompanied by an adult. Call the police at 238-4422 if you sense an intruder.
8. The Board of Directors is considering the purchase of additional surveillance cameras for the clubhouse to curtail said vandalism. Furthermore, the Board is soliciting proposals to change the clubhouse entry system.
9. The Chappaqua Police Department has agreed to accept Old Farm Lake surveillance tapes as proof of wrongdoing.
10. Your Old Farm Lake Board of Directors will prosecute to the fullest extent of the law any vandal invading our peaceful community.
11. Parents will be held responsible for illegal acts of their children.
12. Acts of vandalism at OFL are reported to the police and invariably appear in newspapers. **THESE ACTS COST ALL OF US MONEY AND RUIN THE REPUTATION OF OUR COMMUNITY.**
