

Pool Committee Meeting
Saturday, May 18, 2002

Pool Committee members **in attendance**: Amy Ades, Bob Brown, Donna Bucci, Melanie Gerber and Pool Committee Chair, Deborah Weiss.

Reviewed the **purpose of the pool committee**: To act as the eyes and ears of the OFL community on all matters pertaining to the swimming pool. To communicate and discuss with other committee members, the comments and suggestions of residents, for the purpose of improving the quality of life around the pool and making recommendations to the Old Farm Lake Board of Directors.

The following **items were discussed** and where noted, resolved:

- ◆ Dwyer Paulsen appointed as Head Guard for OFL this summer.
- ◆ The number of guests will not be limited at this time however *minor* guests will be required to have an adult resident accompany them. (Minor residents may still use the pool with a non-resident adult, i.e. babysitter.)
- ◆ Adult only hours are not recommended at this time.
- ◆ Lap lane is not recommended at this time.
- ◆ “Swim at your own risk” hours are not recommended at this time.
- ◆ Offering a Pool Safety and/or First Aid class will be explored by Deborah Weiss.
- ◆ A proposal for a Residents Aerobics class, more vigorous than the currently held Seniors Aerobics class, will be submitted by Amy Ades.
- ◆ Lifeguard bathing suits will not be required at this time, however a labeled “Lifeguard Chair” should be designated for use, enabling residents to easily identify our ‘guard on duty’.
- ◆ Notice of “Pizza Tuesday” to be included in Pool Memo.
- ◆ A Survey on pool issues should be sent to all residents.
- ◆ A Suggestion Box will be placed at the pool sign-in desk and will be checked regularly by the pool committee.
- ◆ Pool BBQ / Family Day to be included in Pool Survey.
- ◆ Kiddie Pool will not be considered at this time.
- ◆ Need for long-term Capital Projects (pool sandblasting, concrete re-surfacing, pool furniture repair and replacement, pool heater, key card entry into the pool area via possible extension of current clubhouse Secura-key system) to be reviewed at a future meeting. Bob Brown gave a “show and tell” of the escalating shifting of the concrete surface surrounding the pool.
- ◆ Feasibility of a daily 4pm ice cream truck visit to the clubhouse parking lot will be explored by Melanie Gerber.
- ◆ Pool Hours on Friday evenings, in July only, to be extended until 9 p.m.
